## Subject Assessment Headlines:

Spanish is assessed at regular intervals by the class teacher, and at the end of each term using the 'puzzle it out' activities on the Primary Languages Network as a way to see what children have achieved and what they need further support with. Work uploaded to Seesaw is assigned a skill (which is given a 3-start rating either red, amber, green) to build up a picture of which skills have been covered. This, along with teacher assessment provides the children with a level at the end of the year.
